ELIGIBILITY TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP:

The following individuals are eligible to apply for a scholarship under the Scholarship Program:

Any child (natural or adopted) of an IBEW member who is (i) unmarried, (ii) under 30 years of age and (iii) has been admitted or is already enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited post-secondary institution is eligible to apply for a scholarship under the Scholarship Program. The applicant's parent or adoptive parent who is an IBEW member must have satisfied all of the eligibility requirements of the Educational Fund at the time of application.

Any child (natural or adopted) of a deceased IBEW member who is (I) unmarried, (ii) under 30 years of age and (iii) has been admitted or is already enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited post-secondary institution is eligible to apply for a scholarship under the Scholarship Program. The applicant's parent or adoptive parent who is a deceased IBEW member must have satisfied all of the eligibility requirements of the Educational Fund at the time of death.

II Application Process:

- A. All active members of the Union and families of deceased members who were active in the Union at the time of death will receive a notification indicating that scholarship applications are available. Interested persons should write to IBEW Local 683, Educational Trust Fund, P.O. Box 39387, St. Louis, MO 63139, or call (844)683-0683 to request scholarship applications.
- B. Candidates must do all of the following requirements in the appropriate category listed below (1 or 2) by the deadline date of July 1 or their applications will not receive full consideration:
 - 1. Candidates not currently enrolled or have never completed a term in postsecondary institution must:
 - a. Take the ACT or SAT as early as possible in the senior year and have the scores submitted to IBEW by July 1st. Information about the time and place of examinations can be obtained from a high school counselor.
 - b. Complete the application and personal statement and submit to IBEW by July 1st.
 - c. Have high school counselor complete the high school recommendation and send official transcript to IBEW by July 1st.
 - 2. Candidates currently enrolled or have completed more than one term in postsecondary institutions must:
 - a. Complete the application and personal statement and submit to IBEW by July 1st.
 - b. Have all previous or current postsecondary institutions send transcripts for every term of the last academic year in attendance to IBEW by July 1st.

III Selection Procedures:

- A. Verification of eligibility of the parent or adoptive parent of the applicant (as an IBEW member or deceased IBEW member who has satisfied all of the eligibility requirements of the Educational Fund) will be determined by the Fund Trustees, the Administrative Manager and/or any other individual or entity designated by the Fund Trustees.
- B. An impartial committee will review all candidates and recommend to the Union in priority order the candidates to receive scholarships.
- C. The amount in the Educational Fund each year will determine the number and size of scholarships awarded, but Fund Trustees are not obligated to award all funds available in a given year.

IV Selection Criteria:

- A. Preference will be given applicants who are survivors of a deceased IBEW member who satisfied all of the eligibility requirements of the Educational Fund at the time of death.
- B. No preference will be given to any groups such as first-time, renewal, or graduate or professional students.
- C. Selection will be made without regard to race, color, or creed.
- D. Grade point average, strength of curriculum, standardized test scores if not currently enrolled in postsecondary in situations or have not been for at least one term, and to a minor degree, extracurricular activities and leadership.
 E. Application, personal statement, and high school recommendation, if required.
- F. Gift support from sources other than family can affect standing in priority and the amount of the scholarships.
- G. May be renewable based upon grade point average, strength of curriculum, the recipients' meeting all other eligibility criteria, and to a minor degree extracurricular activities and leadership.

V Renewal Application Procedures:

- A. Complete the application and personal statement and submit to IBEW by July 1.
- B. Submit a transcript of postsecondary institution grades for every term of the last academic year to the Fund Office by. July 1.
- C. Scholarships are competitive and are not automatically renewable.-Renewal candidates should review section (s) IV.A, B, C, F, and G.

VI Payment Procedures:

- A. Students who are awarded scholarships should obtain scholarship checks each term from the appropriate disbursing offices at their institutions. Checks will be mailed each term of the academic year.
- B. The disbursing agency for the Educational Fund is the IBEW Local 683, Educational Trust Fund, P.O. Box 39387, St. Louis, MO 63139.
- C. Before scholarship checks for the second and subsequent terms will be sent to the institutions for release to students, copies of grades for the term just completed must be sent by the student or the institution to the disbursing agency.
